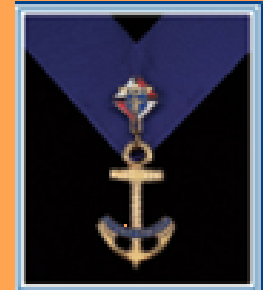

Brother Knights,

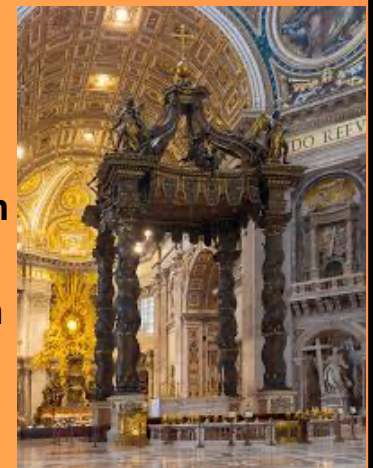


As you may know, I have been to Italy this Christmas Holiday and visit the Vatican. While there, I found out that the Knights of Columbus (Cavalieri di Colombo) have a very strong historical and physical presence in the Vatican and Rome, acting as one of the main arms of financial and logistical support for the popes for more than a century.



The Knights financed several of the most important renovations of St. Peter's Basilica.

The Bernini's Canopy in 2024/2025, the Knights financed the complete restoration (budgeted at about 750,000 euros) of the iconic bronze structure 30 meters high on the papal altar. The facade of St. Peter's Basilica, the Knights also paid for the cleaning and restoration of the main



entrance of the basilica for the Jubilee of the year 2000. They financed improvements and restorations in the areas where the tombs of the



popes are. They also supported the restoration of a 14th century crucifix, the oldest in the basilica.

GK Comments



Although technically outside the Vatican walls, the Knights have several leisure and sports centers in Rome (the Playgrounds). In 1920, Pope Benedict XV asked the order for help to offer safe spaces for the young people of the city after the First World War. One of these original lands was donated by the Knights to the Vatican so that the Paul VI Room (where the papally audiences take place) could be built. In return, the Vatican ceded a new nearby land for the new Oratory of St. Peter.



And there is the "Vicarius Christi" Fund, this is a fund held by the Knights whose proceeds are personally delivered to the Pope every year. This money is used by the Pontiff for his personal charitable works around the world, helping populations in situations of disaster, war or extreme poverty.

I thought these findings illustrate the presence and importance of the Knights of Columbus not only in the U.S., but also in Rome. Italian brothers who also believe in Charity, Unit and Fraternity just like us.

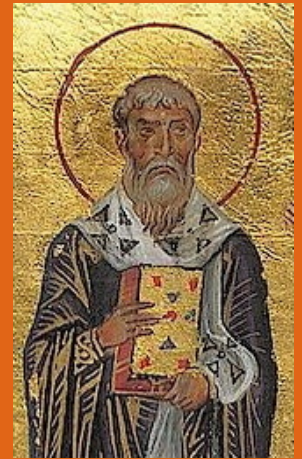

No 2. Anacletus (80 – 92)

Pope Anacletus (born c. AD 16 – died c. AD 92), also known as Cletus, was the bishop of Rome, following Peter and Linus. Anacletus served between c. AD 80 and his death, c. AD 92. Cletus was a Roman who, during his tenure as pope, ordained a number of priests and is traditionally credited with setting up about twenty-five parishes in Rome. He died a martyr, perhaps about 91.*
