On June 19st the parish held the Corpus Christi procession. However, before the march several of our brother Knights help direct parking for this event. Thanks guys.



Saint Basil the Great (330 - 379)

Basil of Caesarea, also called Saint Basil the Great¹ was an early Roman Christian prelate who served as Bishop of Caesarea in Cappadocia from 370 until his death in 379. He was an influential theologian who supported the Nicene Creed and opposed the heresies of the early Christian church such as Arianism and Apollinarianism. Basil established guidelines for monastic life which focus on community life, liturgical prayer, and manual labor. *


