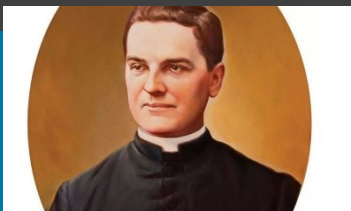

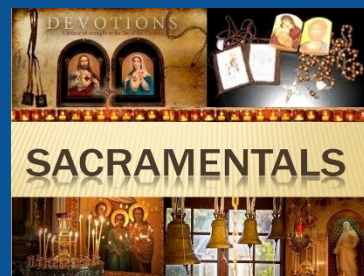


Catholic Facts

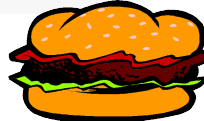
STREET CLEANUP
